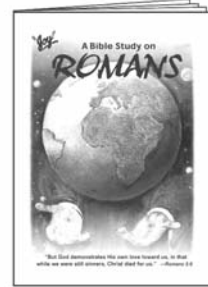

Wounded Man Saved

"A young Zulu man had come in with gunshot wounds, in great pain and waiting for an operation.
