


(This verse shows we never could have come from an animal.)

The woman disobeys the command of God.


GENESIS 3:4—"And the serpent said unto the woman, 'You shall not surely die.'"

GENESIS 3:6—"And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat."

(Revelation 20:2 gives the names of the serpent which deceives mankind: "...the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan....")

Satan, the enemy of our soul, is a big liar. We should never listen to him.

God Calls to Adam, "Where Are You?"

GENESIS 3:9-11—"9And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said to him, 'Where are you?'

"10And he said, 'I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked, and I hid myself.'

"11And He said, 'Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded you that you should not eat?'"

Adam and Eve Make Excuses for Their Sins.

GENESIS 3:12-15—"12And the man said, 'The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.' ¹³And the LORD God said unto the woman, 'What is this that you have done?' And the woman said, 'The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.' ¹⁴And the LORD God said unto the serpent, 'Because you have done this, you are cursed above all cattle, and above every beast in the field; . . . ¹⁵and I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; it shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel.'"

SATAN STOLE THE HEARTS OF ADAM AND EVE AWAY FROM GOD. NOW THEY WILL DIE!

ADAM AND EVE MUST LEAVE THE BEAUTIFUL GARDEN OF EDEN

Genesis 3:23, 24—"²³Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from which he was taken. ²⁴So He drove out the man; and He placed at the east of the garden of Eden cherubim, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life."

THE GROUND IS CURSED BECAUSE OF ADAM'S SIN.

GENESIS 3:17-19—"¹⁷And to Adam He said, 'Because you . . . have eaten of the tree, of which I commanded you, saying, You shall not eat of it: cursed is the ground for your sake; in sorrow you shall eat of it all the days of your life. ¹⁸Thorns and thistles shall it bring forth to you; and you shall eat the herb of the field. ¹⁹In the sweat of your face shall you eat bread, till you return unto the ground; for out of it you were taken. . . . '"

GOD MAKES CLOTHES FOR ADAM AND EVE.


GENESIS 3:21—"Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them."

EVE ALSO HAS SORROW BECAUSE OF DISOBEDIENCE.

GENESIS 3:16—"Unto the woman He said, 'I will greatly multiply your sorrow ... in sorrow you shall bring forth children; and your desire shall be to your husband, and he shall rule over you.'"

Disobedience to God's command brought sin and death into this beautiful world.

have everlasting life."



GOD SENT HIS SON TO RESCUE US



To enter the human race, the Son of God had to come as a human baby, too.

"And she [Mary] shall bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS: for He shall save His people from their sins" (Matthew 1:21).

GOD CHOSE THE VIRGIN MARY TO BE THE MOTHER OF JESUS

(Luke 1:26-35)

"26And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth, ²⁷to a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the **virgin's name was Mary.** ²⁸And the angel came in unto her and said, 'Hail, you that are highly favored, the Lord is with you: blessed are you among women.' ²⁹And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. ³⁰And **the angel said unto her, 'Fear not Mary: for you have found favor with God.** ³¹And, behold, you shall conceive in your womb, and bring forth a Son, **and shall call His name JESUS.** ³²He **shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest:** and the Lord God shall give unto Him the throne of His father David: ³³And He shall reign over the house of Jacob forever; and of His kingdom there shall be no end.' ³⁴Then said Mary unto the angel, 'How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?' ³⁵And the angel answered and said unto her, 'The Holy Spirit shall come upon you, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow you: therefore also that holy One who shall be born of you shall be called the Son of God.'"

THE VIRGIN MARY GIVES BIRTH TO JESUS CHRIST, OUR SAVIOR FROM SIN. (Matthew 1:18-25)

"18Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as His mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a public example, purposed to put her



away privately. ²⁰But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, 'Joseph, son of David, fear not to take unto you Mary your wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy


Spirit. ²¹And she shall bring forth a son, and you shall call His name JESUS: for He shall save His people from their sins.' ²²Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, ²³'Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call His name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.' ²⁴Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife: ²⁵and knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn Son: and he called His name JESUS."

SOMETHING TO REMEMBER

Before Jesus came to earth, He shared great glory with His Father. In John 17:5, Jesus prayed, "And now, O Father, glorify Me with Your own self with the glory which I had with You before the world was."

Jesus is also called Emmanuel, meaning "God with us."

SHEPHERDS ARE THE FIRST TO HEAR OF THE BIRTH OF JESUS



The shepherds will go to Bethlehem to find Jesus.

SHEPHERDS FIND BABY JESUS IN A MANGER

Luke 2:1-20

"¹And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. ²(And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) ³And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city. ⁴And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) ⁵to be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

"6And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. ⁷And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped Him in swaddling clothes, and laid Him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

"8And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. 9And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were greatly afraid. 10And the angel said unto them, 'Fear not: for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

¹¹For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. ¹²And this shall be a sign unto you; you shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.

"¹³And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, ¹⁴'Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace, good will toward men.'

"15And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, 'Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord has made known unto us.' ¹⁶And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger.

"¹⁷And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the saying which was told them concerning this child. ¹⁸And all they that heard it wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds. ¹⁹But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart. ²⁰And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them."



The shepherds will praise God for all they have heard and seen.

WISE MEN ALSO COME TO WORSHIP JESUS



"¹¹When they [wise men from the East] saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy. ¹¹And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped Him; and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto Him gifts: gold, and frankincense, and myrrh. ¹²And being warned of God in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they departed into their own country another way" (Matthew 2:10-12).

Sometimes God speaks to people in dreams yet today.

JESUS IS BAPTIZED BY JOHN THE BAPTIST



MATTHEW 3:13-17

"13Then came Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized by him. ¹⁴But John forbad Him, saying, I have need to be baptized by You, and You come to me?' ¹⁵And Jesus answering said unto him, 'Permit it to be so now: for thus it becomes us to fulfill all righteousness.' Then he permitted Him. ¹⁶And Jesus, when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him: ¹⁷And lo: a voice from heaven, saying, 'This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.'"

THREE UNUSUAL WITNESSES


- **1.God, the FATHER,** who spoke from heaven, saying, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."
- **2. God, the SON,** who was being baptized by John the Baptist. His human name was Jesus because He came to save us from our sins.
- **3. God, the HOLY SPIRIT,** who came down from heaven like a dove, resting upon Jesus.

HOW WONDERFUL THAT GOD SHOWED HIMSELF TO US IN THESE THREE UNUSUAL WAYS!

JESUS CHRIST IS TRULY THE SON OF THE LIVING GOD

Jesus had no human father. Before Joseph took Mary to be his wife, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit.

(Now read page 7 again, especially Matthew 1: 20-23.)



The Bible verses in Matthew 1:20-23 on page 7 show us that God is the Father of Jesus because the Holy Spirit and God are ONE. 1 John 5:7 says, "For there are THREE that bear record in heaven, the FATHER, the WORD, and the HOLY SPIRIT: and these THREE are ONE." Another name for Jesus is the WORD. In John 1:14 we read, "And the WORD was made flesh, and dwelt among us..." This shows that Jesus is ONE with the FATHER, too. In fact, Jesus clearly tells us in John 10:30, "I and My Father are ONE." How wonderful that God's only begotten Son came to be with us and to die for our sins! "God was manifest in the flesh…" (1 Timothy 3:16).

God says Jesus is His Son in Luke 9:35: "This is My beloved SON: hear Him." Since Jesus and the Father are ONE, let us give honor to God's Son the same as we do to God. John 5:23 says: "That all men should honor the SON, even as they honor the FATHER. He that honors not the Son honors not the Father who has sent Him."

"For in Him [Christ] dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily" (Colossians 2:9).

JESUS IS GOD—HE CAME IN HUMAN FORM.

JESUS DOES NOT YIELD TO THE TEMPTATION OF THE DEVIL

Jesus "was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin" (Hebrews 4:15). Jesus never obeyed the devil.



Matthew 4:1-11

"Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He afterward hungered. And when the tempter came to Him, he said, 'If You are the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.' But He answered and said, 'It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.' Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, and set Him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto Him, If You are the Son of God, cast Yourself down: for it is written. He shall give His angels charge concerning you: and in their hands they shall bear you up, lest at any time you dash your foot against a stone.' Jesus said unto him, 'It is written again, You shall not tempt the Lord your God.' Again, the devil took Him up into an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; and said unto Him, 'All these things will I give You, if You will fall down and worship me.' Then said Jesus unto him, 'Get you hence, Satan: for it is written, You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only shall you serve.' Then the devil left Him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto Him."

IN EACH TEMPTATION BY THE DEVIL, JESUS USED THE WORD OF GOD TO OVERCOME HIM.

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

(Exodus 20:3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 12-17)

The basis of moral law that God gave to Moses

(First four: love for God)

- 1. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
- 2. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything. ... Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them.
- 3. Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain.
- 4. Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

(Last six: love for man)

- 5. Honor thy father and thy mother.
- 6. Thou shalt not kill.
- 7. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- 8. Thou shalt not steal.
- 9. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
- 10. Thou shalt not covet... any thing that is thy neighbor's.

(KJV)

On page 13, Jesus used the first commandment In defeating and resisting the devil. We should use Scripture, too.

WHY WE SHOULD LEARN THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

- **1. "The law was our schoolmaster** to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith." —Galatians 3:24 (Read Galatians 2:16.)
- 2. Jesus said in Matthew 5:17—"Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill."
- **3. Jesus mentions other commandments** in Mark 10:17-22, Luke 10:25-28 and Luke 18:18-24. (See also Romans 13:9.) **It is important** to know the ten commandments and also the two great commandments.


THE TWO GREAT COMMANDMENTS

- **1. Love for God.** Jesus said, "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and will all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment." —Matthew 22:37, 38
- **2. Love for man.** "And the second is like unto it, "Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself." —Matthew 22:39

(All the ten commandments above are included in the two great commandments. In Matthew 22:40 Jesus says, "On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.")

"LOVE WORKS NO ILL TO HIS NEIGHBOR: THEREFORE LOVE IS THE FULFILLING OF THE LAW." —ROMANS 13:10

JESUS CHOOSES HELPERS—"Come, follow Me."



Matthew 4:17-20

"17From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, 'Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.' 18And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. 19And He said unto them, 'Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.' 20And they straightway left their nets, and followed Him."

JESUS STILL CALLS TO US—"Come, follow Me."


SOME MIRACLES JESUS DID WHILE ON EARTH



CLEANSED THE LEPER

(Matthew 8:2, 3)


"...There came a leper and worshipped Him, saying, 'Lord, if You will, You can make me clean.' And Jesus put forth His hand, and touched him, saying, 'I will; be clean.' And immediately his leprosy was cleansed."



STILLED THE STORM

(Matthew 8:24-26)

"...There arose a great tempest in the sea ...the ship was covered with the waves: but He [Jesus] was asleep. And His disciples came to Him, and awoke Him, saying, 'Lord, save us: we perish.' And He said unto them, 'Why are you fearful, O you of little faith?' Then He arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm."



HEALED THE BLIND

(Mark 10:46-47, 52)

"...Blind Bartimaeus...sat by the highway side begging.... He began to cry out and say, 'Jesus, thou son of David, have mercy on me.'... And Jesus said unto him, 'Go your way: your faith has made you whole.' And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus...."

FED THE MULTITUDE


(John 6:9-12)

"'There is a lad here, who has five barley loaves, and two small fishes....' And Jesus said, 'Make the men sit down.' ... So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. And Jesus took the loaves; and when He had given thanks, He distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were sitting down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would. When they were filled, He said unto His disciples, 'Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.'"

JESUS CHRIST HAS POWER TO FORGIVE SINS



The man with palsy is let down through the roof.

MARK 2:1-12

"1And again He entered into Capernaum ... and it was noised that He was in the house. ²And straightway many were gathered together...so there was no room to receive them, no, not so much as about the door: and He preached the word unto them. ³And they came unto Him, bringing one sick of the palsy, who was borne by four. ⁴And when they could not come near unto Him . . . they uncovered the roof where He was: and...let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay. 5When Jesus saw their faith, He said unto the sick of the palsy, 'Son, your sins be forgiven you.' 6But there were certain of the scribes sitting there, and reasoning in their hearts, '7...Who can forgive sins

but God only?' 8... When Jesus perceived in His spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, He said unto them,... '9Which is easier to say to the sick of the palsy, Your sins be forgiven you; or to say, Arise, and take up your bed and walk? ¹⁰But that you may know that the Son of man has power on earth to forgive sins,' (He said to the sick of the palsy,) '11... Arise, and take up your bed, and go your way into your house.' ¹²And immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went forth...; they were all amazed, and glorified God...."

CHRIST HAS POWER OVER DEATH

JOHN 11:39-44


"39 Jesus said, 'Take away the stone.' Martha, the sister of him that was dead, said unto Him, 'Lord, by this time he stinks; for he has been dead four days.' 40 Jesus said unto her, 'Said I not unto you, that, if you would believe, you should see the glory of God?' 41 Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid.... 43 He cried with a loud voice, 'Lazarus, come forth.' 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus said unto them, 'Loose him, and let him go.'"



Lazarus comes forth from the dead.

JESUS SAID, "I AM THE RESURRECTION, AND THE LIFE: HE THAT BELIEVES IN ME, THOUGH HE WERE DEAD, YET SHALL HE LIVE: AND WHOSOEVER LIVES AND BELIEVES IN ME SHALL NEVER DIE. DO YOU BELIEVE THIS?" (John 11:25, 26).

JESUS GIVES HIS LIFE TO SAVE US FROM OUR SINS



CHRIST'S DEATH WAS NOT AN ACCIDENT. IT WAS PART OF GOD'S PLAN.

Jesus, of His own free will, laid down His life to save you and me from our sins. John 10:18 says: "No man takes it [My life] from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again..."

Because Jesus had no sin, He became our perfect sacrifice. "... Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29).

- 2. "... The blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin" (1 John 1:7).
- **3.** "Being...justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him" (Romans 5:9).
- 4. "In whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins" (Colossians 1:14).

JESUS IS OUR ONLY WAY TO GOD

- 1 John 5:11— "... God has given to us eternal life, and this life is in His Son."
- Romans 6:23—"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."



STEPS TO FIND JESUS

- 1. **Repent.** Be truly sorry for your sins. (To repent means "sorry enough to quit doing wrong—to quit sinning.")
- 2. **Confess** your sins to Jesus. (Confess means to "tell, admit.") **1 John 1:9** says, "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
- 3. **Forsake** your sins. (Forsake means to "give up, leave alone.") "He that covers his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesses and forsakes them shall have mercy" (Proverbs 28:13).
- 4. **Believe on Christ** as your Savior.
 - **John 3:16**—"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."
 - Acts 16:31—"Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you shall be saved...."
- 5. **Receive Him** into your heart (open the door of your heart and let Him come in). **John 1:12** says, "As many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name."


A Prayer Guide

NINE GUIDELINES FOR FOLLOWING JESUS

Jesus said, "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me" (John 10:27).



- 1. Read in God's Word, the Holy Bible, every day. Learn Bible verses which will help you grow to be like Jesus Christ. If you have no Bible, memorize verses in this book. They will help you. "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path" (Psalm 119:105).
- 2. Pray any time of the day or night (Psalm 55:17). Prayer is heart-communion with God. Tell Him how you love Him. Thank Him for His blessings, HOTA for saving your soul. Ask Him for anything you need. There is strength in prayer. Luke 18:1 says, "Men ought always to pray, and not to faint." Isaiah 40:31 says, "They that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength." Psalm 55:22 says, "Cast your burden upon the LORD, and He shall sustain you....

"In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (1 Thess. 5:18).

3. Keep your thoughts pure.

WHAT TO THINK ABOUT

"Whatever things are TRUE, Whatever things are HONEST, Whatever things are JUST, Whatever things are PURE, Whatever things are LOVELY, Whatever things are of GOOD REPORT. If there be any **VIRTUE**, If there be any PRAISE, THINK ON THESE THINGS." (Philippians 4:8)

Our Thought Life Is Important to God

"... Bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ." —2 Corinthians 10:5

Resist every bad thought—start praising God—think on good things. What to do with bad thoughts...

Throw away every bad thought that comes to you! It is Satan's trick to bring bad thoughts to our minds. A bad thought is not our thought unless we want it to be our thought. We can decide to throw away that bad thought or we can decide to make it ours. Pray to Jesus. He will help you throw away any bad thought. REMEMBER: "We cannot help it if the birds fly over our heads but we can prevent them from making a nest in our hair." So it is with the bad thoughts. They may come flying to us and want to enter our minds but we can refuse them. Right away think on the good things. Jesus tells us what to think about.

Read Philippians 4:8 in the box at the left.

This verse says to think about whatever things are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, and of good report.

- Resist the devil—draw near to God. James 4:7, 8—"... Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you...."
- Trust in the LORD. As Proverbs 3:5 says, "Trust in the LORD with all your heart; and lean not unto your own understanding." Romans 8:28—"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose."
- Do the will of God with gladness. In Psalm **40:8** we read, "I delight to do Your will, O my God...."
 - **1 Thessalonians 4:3—**"This is the will of God, even your sanctification, that you should abstain from fornication" (means not to have sex before marriage).

Leviticus 20:7—"Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be holy: for I am the LORD your God." 1 Timothy 5:22—"Keep yourself pure."

1 Peter 1:15—"...Be holy in all manner of conversation."

BIBLE

7. Show love to all people.

Ephesians 4:32—"Be kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake has forgiven you."

John 13:35—"By this shall all men know that you are My disciples, if you have love one to another."

- 8. Sing, rejoice, keep praising the Lord. **Ephesians 5:19—**"Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord." **Psalm 50:23a—**"Whoever offers praise glorifies
- 9. Keep walking in the light God gives you. **1 John 1:7—**"But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin."

And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen."

*You should memorize this prayer. Throughout the world this prayer is often sung or prayed by believers in unison (all together).

PRIVATE PRAYER IS ALSO IMPORTANT

Matthew 6:6—"But you, when you pray, enter into your closet, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret shall reward you openly."

WHEN WE PRAY, WE MUST ALSO FORGIVE

Mark 11:25, 26—"And when you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against any: that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father who is in heaven forgive your trespasses."

PROMISES GOD MAKES TO THOSE WHO PRAY

1 John 5:14, 15—"And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us: And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him."

WE MUST PRAY IN FAITH BELIEVING

Mark 11:24—"... What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them."

IT IS GOOD TO PRAY WITH OTHER BELIEVERS

Matthew 18:19, 20—Jesus said, "If two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of My Father who is in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, there am I in the midst of them."

WE CAN PRAY FOR HEALING WHEN WE ARE SICK

James 5:14-16—"Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up.... Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that you may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much."

OBEDIENCE TO GOD BRINGS ANSWERS TO OUR PRAYERS

1 John 3:22—"And whatever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight."

PRAYER IS HEART-COMMUNION WITH GOD

(This means talking from our hearts to God and also letting God talk to our hearts.)

Remember to pray prayers of thanksgiving and praise to God. We honor Him by being grateful and blessing His name. The Psalms are full of prayers and rejoicing. We can pray while sitting, standing, kneeling, lying down, or in any posture.

- 1. King David prayed a wonderful prayer as he **sat** before the Lord (2 Samuel 7:18-29). He often praised the Lord in his prayers. He wrote most of the Psalms.
- 2. On the day King Solomon dedicated the house of the Lord, he **stood with his hands spread out toward heaven**. Somewhere during this prayer, he **kneeled** on his knees with his hands still spread out to heaven (1 Kings 8:22-54).
- 3. Daniel prayed three times a day upon his knees and gave thanks (Daniel 6:10).
- 4. Jonah prayed to the Lord **out of the great fish's belly** (Jonah chapter 2).

MATTHEW 21:22—"ALL THINGS, WHATEVER YOU SHALL ASK IN PRAYER, BELIEVING, YOU SHALL RECEIVE."

EVERYBODY WILL BE RAISED FROM THE DEAD

1. Some to the resurrection of life

2. Some to the resurrection of damnation

John 5:28, 29—"Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in which all that are in the graves shall hear His voice, and shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation."

No believer has all the gifts, and not all believers have the same gift. Which gift has God given you?

1 Corinthians 12:1, 4-11, 27-31—"¹Now concerning spiritual gifts . . . I would not have you ignorant. . . . ⁴Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. ⁶And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God who works all in all. ¹But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit therewith. ⁶For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; ¹oto another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; ¹oto another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another various kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: ¹¹But all these work that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He wills. ["Severally" means "individually."] ²¬Now you are the body of Christ, and members in particular. ²¬&And God has set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. ²¬¬Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles? ³¬¬Are all the gifts of healing? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? ¬¬¬¬Are accepted to the gifts and yet show I unto you a more excellent way."

HIS COMING WILL BE SUDDEN, LIKE LIGHTNING

Matthew 24:27—"For as the lightning comes out of the east, and shines even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be."

NO ONE KNOWS THE DAY NOR HOUR

Matthew 24:36, 42—"³⁶But of that day and hour knows no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but My Father only. ⁴²Watch therefore: for you know not what hour your Lord comes."

BEWARE OF FALSE CHRISTS AND FALSE PROPHETS

Matthew 24:23-26—"23... If any man shall say unto you, 'Lo, here is Christ,' or 'There;' believe it not. ²⁴For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders.... ²⁶Wherefore if they shall say to you, 'Behold, He is in the desert;' go not out: 'Behold, He is in the secret chambers;' believe it not."

666 IS THE NUMBER OF THE BEAST

Revelation 13:17,18—"... No man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Here is wisdom. Let him that has understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is six hundred threescore and six [666]."

Also read Revelation 14:9-13. The wrath of God will be poured out on all who worship the beast or his image or receive his mark.
