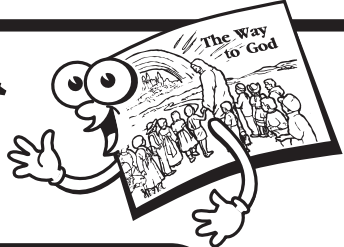
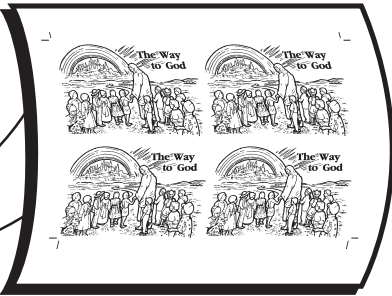


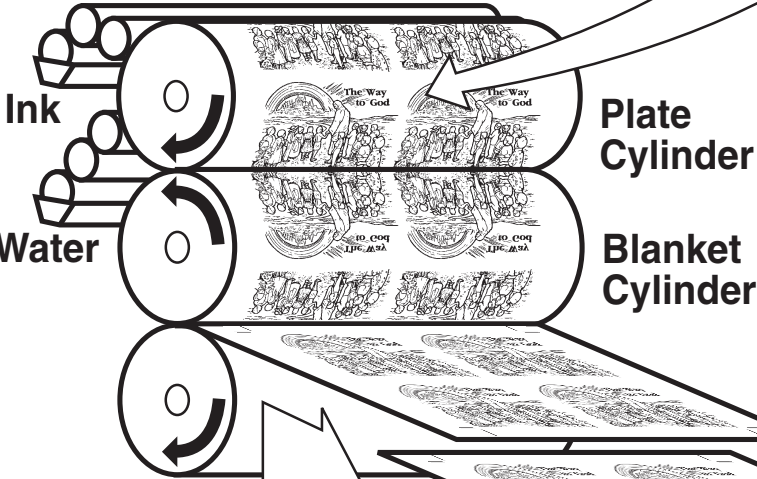
ONCE ALL THE BOOKLET PAGES ARE TYPESET, THEY ARE PRINTED FROM THE COMPUTER AND MADE INTO A METAL FLAT SHEET CALLED A PLATE.



THE PLATE IS BENT AROUND A CYLINDER ON THE PRINTING PRESS. THE INK MIXES WITH WATER AND STICKS TO THE PLATE, THEN THE PLATE ROLLS AGAINST THE BLANKET.

THE BLANKET RECEIVES THE INK FROM THE PLATE AND ROLLS AGAINST THE PAPER. THE PAPER COMES OFF THE PRESS WITH ALL THE WORDS AND PICTURES, READY TO BE FOLDED AND TRIMMED INTO BOOKLETS.
