- 17 PRAY for continued fruitfulness for Every Home for Christ (EHC) as they work to reach every home in the world. PRAY that God will provide every resource needed to fulfill their mission. "And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come" (Matthew 24:14).
- 18 PRAISE God for the way the Lord has provided several new employees; and PRAY for a few remaining key people needed. Visit wmpress.org/job-openings for more info. "And the LORD, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you....Do not fear nor be dismayed" (Deuteronomy 31:8).
- 19 PRAY against the increased Internet censorship around the world so that Scriptures can be available to those who are hungry for them.
 - "The Word of God is not chained" (2 Tim. 2:9b).
- 20 PRAY that WMP's newly revised Meditations in the Psalms study booklet will help believers focus on prayer, petition, thanksgiving and praise through selected Psalms.
 - "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him and bless His name" (Psalm 100:4).
- 21 PRAY that many in Israel will develop interest in reading God's Word and will find out who Jesus really is.

- **30** PRAISE God for enabling a large printing of *The Path to Life* handout in English, Spanish, Portuguese (first time) and French. Pray that many will be drawn to life-giving truth through this evangelistic tool.

Dear Prayer Team,

Bad news makes us pray "hard"; often appealing to God's love for us. This is implied in the message sent to Jesus in John chapter 11: "Lord, behold, he whom You love is sick." (v. 3) But God doesn't always respond as we wish. Lazarus dies. When Jesus finally arrives in Bethany, the loss and grief of Martha and Mary are evident. Like us, they ask Jesus the big "WHY?" At the tomb Martha refers to the smell of a dead body. Our crisis often has the smell of death, an ending, a break or loss. Grief, despondency, discouragement and depression, bordering on bitterness may set in. In time, however, God makes good on His promise that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose (Ro. 8:28). Our experience and prayers aren't forgotten or minimized, but, as He wills, a different life arises out of the crisis.

Four truths encourage us in our crisis: 1. Jesus loved Lazarus and He loves us too. 2. We can rest in the truth that Jesus knows the outcome of our crisis. Jesus knew Lazarus would live and yet it is recorded that Jesus groaned within, and openly wept. He was struck by the fear, the anxiety, the hopelessness and helplessness. He felt the sting of death. 3. Cling to the truth that Jesus takes into Himself our suffering and pain. "By His stripes we are healed" (ls. 53:5).

The fourth truth, Jesus says, is that our crisis is "for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it" (v 4). The crisis Lazarus suffered helped people believe in Jesus as Messiah. (See verses 15, 26, and 40-42.) Those believers led the triumphal entry into Jerusalem (John 12:17,18). His purpose for our crisis isn't always as clear, but as our crisis subsides let us give witness and praise, celebrating His grace, mercy and goodness.

- 3 PRAISE God for new staff members, Maria, Steve, Susie, Joshua, Mike, Colleen, Immanuel. PRAY for grace, understanding and insight as they learn the details of their work here.
 - "Not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord" (Romans 12:11).
- 4 PRAY for **Helen** as she communicates with national coordinators and as we interact with shipping agents, freight forwarders, and the truckers who pick up shipments.
- "Pray for us, that the Word of the Lord may have free course and be glorified" (2 Thes.3:1b).
- 5 PRAY for wisdom for WMP's IT Department to keep computers operating well, free from attacks. Pray for Landon in his increased responsibilities and as he interacts with our consultant, Mike, and with MapleTronics, who is handling our IT server and network infrastructure support.

- 9 PRAY for revival to grow in the U.S.A. and that God will bless the various prayer movements that are actively seeking His face on behalf of our nation, that He will grant us His mercy and the wisdom and grace we desperately need.
 - "Seek the LORD while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the LORD, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon" (Isaiah 55:6-7).
- 10 PRAY for WMP staff and volunteers who need God's healing touch. PRAY for daily provision, safety, stamina, wisdom, peace, and grace. Pray for protection from accidents and illness and against all attacks from the enemy. PRAY for family members who need to be saved or to be healed.
 - "Be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord" (1 Corinthians 15:58b).

- 12 PRAY that God will use WMP's mobile app, with more than 650 Scripture booklets available to read on mobile devices (in addition to 39 audio booklets in 14 languages). "Push" notifications can be set to receive daily prayer requests and updates about shipments and new podcasts.

- 13 PRAY for nations with restricted freedoms. PRAY for all who are incarcerated, whether justly or unjustly. PRAY that WMP's Scripturetext Datebook will be a blessing wherever it is used in prisons throughout the U.S.A. Pray that those enslaved to addictions will find true freedom in Christ.
