Not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord. (Romans 12:11)

PRAY for the people who speak Dangme.

19 PRAY for the WMP Board Meeting today as they go over reports, make decisions, and plan for the future. Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide them and give them wisdom.

Be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. (1 Corinthians 15:58b)

PRAY for the people who speak Danish.

20 PRAY the World Prayer Center will be utilized effectively and efficiently. That prayer will be lifted up for WMP, for our local community, for our country, and for the world.

"Lord, teach us to pray." (Luke 11:1b) PRAY for the people who speak Dari.

21 PRAY that all supplies needed—paper, ink, etc.—will be available without undue delays. PRAISE God for recent deliveries of sheet-fed paper for printing covers.

PRAY for the people who speak Cebuano.

4 PRAY for our IT Department, that Mike and Landon have wisdom to keep our computers operating well, and free from cyber attacks.

PRAY for the people who speak Chaldean.

5 PRAY for and PRAISE the Lord, as today WMP hosts an open house, the dedication of the new warehouse, and a celebration dinner commemorating 61 years of ministry.

That you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 15:6).

PRAY for the people who speak Chavacano.

6 This is the International Day of Prayer for Persecuted Christians. PRAY for Christians who are suffering for their faith to be strong in their faith, to be forgiving, full of grace and truth, and to be **bold and wise** in sharing the gospel with hearts who need Jesus.

For the LORD gives wisdom. (Proverbs 2:6a) PRAY for the people who speak Chinese.

8 PRAY for today's elections, and that God would provide Godly leaders for the U.S.A. Pray for revival to grow and that the various prayer movements actively seeking God's mercy and grace on behalf of our nation will flourish.

Seek the LORD while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the LORD, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon. (Isaiah 55:6-7)
