Dear Friends and Prayer Partners,

WMP publishes a Scripture reading schedule to assist a believer's desire to read through the Bible in a year. It is a goal to be encouraged, but maybe you are interested in a different approach to reading through the Bible.

Here is a method for reading through the Bible, which also involves reading four or five chapters a day, but isn't tied to the calendar. Each day read one chapter from an historical book, a poetic book, a prophetic book, a gospel book and an epistle. (To read four chapters a day, combine poetical and prophetic books into one category.) The sense of accomplishment comes as you finish each genre.

The best benefit of this method is that it reads through the 4 Gospels four times each year. Since God the Father wants us to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren (Romans 8:29), what better way to gain an intimate knowledge of Jesus.

Plus, you will read the instructions of the Apostles twice a year — increasing doctrinal knowledge and practical wisdom for daily living.

The Old Testament takes longer. Reading the historical books takes about 15 months. It will take less than 8 months to read through the poetic books and the same for the prophets. (If you wish to read only 4 chapters a day, it will take 15+ months to read the prophets and poets as one category.)

Two other blessings are that your prayers will be enhanced by the amazing connections the Holy Spirit makes between the 5 genres, and, there is no guilt if a day is missed or you feel led to meditate on a passage for a day or two.
