Dear Friends and Prayer Partners,

First Corinthians 12:12-27 is one of four places the Church is likened to the human body. Three principles we can glean from this passage are:

- 1. Commitment: For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body... and have all been made to drink into one Spirit (12:13). The following verses picture the foot saying I am not a hand and an ear lamenting it is not an eye: concluding that they are not part of the body. Remember that the church is a level playing field. We belong. We fit. We participate. Enjoy and own the ministry the Spirit gives you.
- 2. Respect: But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased (12:18). The eye cannot say to the hand I don't need you, nor the head say that to the feet. We are God's gift to the church, but if we are proud of our position or contemptuous of other's gifts or talents, we have forgotten that "God has set the members." The purpose of everyone's presence, talents, experiences, and age is so that there is no division in the body. Mutual respect promotes spiritual unity. Humbly accept God's placement in your fellowship.
- 3. Sympathy and empathy: The members should have the same care for one another. And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it (12:25a, 26). Be conscious of the hurts and pains in the body; encourage, disciple, pray, and exhort. But also remember to celebrate each answer to prayer, each victory over sin, each healing event, each milestone reached, and each day your church has experienced meaningful worship.
