7. Jesus knew His prayer would be answered. He does not say "if," but "when" you return to me. Jesus' prayers for us today are also always answered.

8. When Peter did return to Jesus, his denial did not relegate him to the bottom of the list of Apostles. He is so forgiven, that he is given a call and a mission – to strengthen his brethren. Our repentance and confession brings the same call to our lives. Praising the Name of our Praying Lord,
