(John 1:14)*

Winter Greetings to all my Friends,

Valentine's Day might be celebrated in the midwinter because it warms us with the thoughts of joy and excitement that come with close relationships.

It is the same with the Lord. **For the LORD takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the humble with salvation.** (Psalm 149:4) **God so loved the world ...** (John 3:16a) and with Jesus as our Saviour, we can **rejoice in the LORD and joy in the God of my [our] salvation.** (Habakkuk 3:18)

Psalm 149 details some of the feelings of joy we have in the Lord. **Let the saints be joyful in glory; let them sing aloud on their beds. Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand** (Psalm 149:5-6).

The Psalmist exhorts the church to: **Praise the LORD! Sing to the LORD a new song, and His praise in the assembly of saints. Let them praise His name with the dance; let them sing praises to Him with the timbrel and harp** (Psalm 149:1-3).

Might that sword be the Word of God? **For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword** (Hebrews 4:12a). As in all relationships we show our love best when we live it and proclaim it. **Let all that you do be done with love** (1 Corinthians 16:14).
