


**Help From Above (HFA):** Designed to lead the reader to Christ and to live a victorious life. Good for evangelism and follow-up of new believers.

**Let's Praise the Lord! (PTL):** Especially for Christians. Compiled as a practical tool for praising God faithfully and joyfully.




**The Way to God (WTG):** Especially for children. Its purpose is to share God's love and plan of salvation and how to live for Jesus. Features illustrations and a larger type size.




**Wings Over Zion (WOZ):** Especially for Jewish friends, but is good for all who are interested in Biblical prophecy relating to Israel. (64 pages)




**Victory in Jesus Christ (VJC):** Offers believers victory over the enemy through the power of Christ. Reveals Satan's character and tactics.





**A Bible Study on John (BSJ):** For assurance of salvation and personal growth in the Lord. Can also be used by Christians in sharing their faith. (80 pages)




**A Bible Study on Matthew (MAT):** Teaches simple but important truths for Christian living. (64 pages)








