This Thanksgiving season we are so grateful for God's marvelous ways of getting His Word to people in times of crisis:



- WMP booklets ministered to the earthquake-ravaged villagers of Myanmar in March of this year as the above quote testifies.
- Individuals delivered booklets to the victims of the wildfires in Los Angeles and Hurricane Helene in Tennessee.
- The morning after the Lear jet crashed into Cottman Ave. in Philadelphia distributors were walking the streets and ministering to those in the surrounding buildings.
- New Testaments entered Nicaragua to bring hope in a time of intense political repression.



The *Unburdened* documentary film highlighted the evangelistic endeavors of an ordinary person in Atlanta, Georgia, witnessing for Jesus in ordinary situations near his home. We pray it encourages others to witness and are excited that more people are ordering booklets

We are seeing an increase in volunteers and have new coordinators and expanded outreaches in northern Brazil and Europe.

We are thankful for the many breakthrough moments.

Challenges abound when printing and distributing Scripture–but God prevails.

Two student evangelists in Brazil were printing Bible verses to give out because they could not afford to buy tracts. Then they discovered WMP Scripture booklets!



"When they arrived at my home and saw the boxes, one of them asked if all of that was evangelistic material. I said yes. She asked again, "But is ALL of this material to be given to evangelists?" I said yes again. At that moment, both began to cry with joy. Their eyes filled with tears. They couldn't say anything else—they just wept and praised God. One of them lowered her head in worship, thanking the Lord Jesus for His provision. Her tears were falling on the floor of my house. I've seen evangelists rejoice many times, and I've seen others become emotional, but this was the first time I witnessed such intense gratitude."—Peniel D., Brazil





For several years we have been seeking to send a large quantity of booklets into Cuba. This year it finally happened, but not without obstacles and prayers. All the permissions and details were nailed down in Cuba before we went to production, but when ready to ship, major hurdles arose. It was a special day when we could announce in The Lord chapel that our container was on a ship provided bound for Cuba, and a day of rejoicing \$900,000 when it passed from customs to our coordinator without a problem. in eight

In November 2024, two containers

months! of booklets entered customs in Liberia. one to continue on to Côte d'Ivoire. The governmental changes to the import process resulted in unexpected charges and ten months of demurrage (storage) fees. As the charges were addressed in prayer, the Lord provided a way to greatly reduce the costs and fees and release the containers in September. In response to the news, Helen encouraged our coordinator with these words: "I'm sure there will be much fruit from these Scripture booklets, as the 'battle' to get them released has been long and hard for you and your ministry. Our God is

sovereign, and His purpose will prevail."

Words can hardly express the thrill of breaking production and shipment records. Production increased to twelve million booklets for several months. The 2024-25 fiscal year saw 90 containers of booklets leave our docks, some of

> which included new languages. The previous record was 82.

The Lord provided \$900,000 in eight months to complete the purchase of a second web press and a fourth bindery. Thank you to all who made this possible! The bindery was installed in late September. The estimated press arrival date

is early 2026. The addition of these machines will reduce our vulnerability to mechanical failure and give us the possibility of greater production to meet the growing list of orders for booklets and languages. (Hence the name for the capital campaign, Twelve:24, from Acts 12:24 -

"The Word of God grew and multiplied.")





We appreciate God challenging our faith.

We gratefully acknowledge the Lord's supply of funds through faithful donors and wisdom for the challenges we have encountered. Like many nonprofits in times of inflation and economic uncertainty, we experienced a mid-year slump in donations. As a result, we temporarily reduced production. Nevertheless, we are confident that in His time and His way our faithful Lord will provide everything needed to increase the printing and distribution of His Word through WMP.

This past year the Lord led the leadership of WMP to assess procedures and policies in preparation for growth and long-term sustainability. We pray every day that the Lord's appointed person to be our president will be identified and brought on board. But we are grateful for how active God has been in every aspect of WMP, in our coordinators and distributors, shipments, and in our lives. For that we lift our hearts in praise.
