(The Zarma language is spoken by the Zarma ethnic group, who reside mainly in Niger.)
Blessed be the name of the LORD from this time forth and forevermore! From the rising of the sun to its going down the LORD's name is to be praised.
— Psalm 113:2, 3
- 24 GIVE THANKS** that booklets using new languages are in the final translating and editing process.
(The Zo people live in northern South Asia and Myanmar and speak the Zomi language.)
O LORD, our Lord, how excellent is Your name in all the earth, who have set Your glory above the heavens!
— Psalm 8:1
- 25 GIVE THANKS** for the many language groups and countries of Africa using WMP booklets.
(GIVE THANKS for the 12 million people in South Africa who speak the Zulu language.)
Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands! Serve the LORD with gladness; come before His presence with singing. Know that the LORD, He is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves.
