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Each Booklet: A Seed Sown

For the past 10 years, World Missionary Press has hosted a booth at the Elkhart County (Indiana) 4-H Fair, which is one of the largest in the country with over 200,000 people attending. This year 46 staff and volunteers gave out more than 13,000 booklets in English and Spanish. We also host a children's activity booth. One worker there shared, "We had a great time outdoors, passing out over 600 *God Loves You!* coloring books with crayons to many excited children on Kids' Day." Another worker described how the Lord blessed while serving at the booth: "God is increasing my courage and loving concern for others. The fields are ripe for harvesting. Jesus does the work of changing hearts. Usually others are watering, cultivating, and harvesting. **Scattering seeds is the easiest part.**"



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In our booth we keep a box with at least one booklet in each of the 353 languages produced by WMP. We also display booklets in Russian, French, Ukraine, Japanese, Afrikaans, and others spoken in our county. Some of the traveling carnival workers speak Afrikaans and are delighted to have booklets in their language. These racks are empty by the end of the fair.

It is amazing how many people avert their

attention when walking past the booth. Many look at the merchandise in the booths across the aisle. The owner of one booth did not engage WMP workers for years. This summer, for the first time, she joined a vendor's morning prayer group. She acknowledged that the Fair needs our workers there doing what they do.

The seed is beginning to sprout! Pray that the Lord continues working in her heart.



The ministry of World Missionary Press is to give topical Scripture booklets to as many missionaries, pastors, evangelists, and congregations as possible so they can sow the Word in their country and town. When opportunities present themselves, the WMP team sows locally as well. If we look for them, opportunities abound right in our own backyard.

In addition to the Elkhart County Fair, WMP is also represented at the Rossville Summer's End Festival (just north of Indianapolis) and the

Berrien County Youth Fair (in Berrien Springs, Michigan). The person staffing these booths reports that "almost always on the last night of the fair, something especially encouraging occurs. For example, on the first day a man asked for the language Tok Pisin, which I was able to give him out of the language box. The next day, I restocked the box and put five copies out on the table. Then on the last day, fifteen minutes before closing time, four college students came and were browsing the booklets.





The young lady exclaimed, 'Look, there's our language!' **They were so excited to find the Tok Pisin Scripture booklets so far from Papua New Guinea!** If the man on the first day had not come, the booklets would not have been on the table."

On another day, our representative was overcome by the heat, and he had to leave the booth unattended for a time. When he returned, he noticed that several Arab language booklets had been taken. Perhaps some Arab women, who are not supposed to speak with men, saw an opportunity in his absence to take a booklet. "Those kinds of things make it a lot of fun. God gives me encouragement to do it

again next year. It's an opportunity to share the gospel and encourage others to be involved in an outreach in their town events, Saturday markets, or parades. When someone says, 'I don't need that; I am a Christian,' I say, 'This isn't for you, it's for you to give to others.'"
