Africa, Europe, and Latin America

Forty of Africa's 58 countries received 37% of WMP's recent production, with the 33 countries of South and Central America close behind. It is also exciting to see a growing number of orders from across the continent of Europe.

By offering free topical Scripture booklets in 353 languages, WMP provides unique ministry tools for multiple nations, available to rich and poor, privileged and underprivileged, native and foreigner. For example, Charissa and her family used a vacation to witness in the Czech Republic and Hungary. They brought 1,000 booklets in 50 languages to hand out to tourists, workers from other nations, and displaced Ukrainians.

anywhere. Eduardo, a native fisherman on the Pilcomayo River, bordering Argentina and Paraguay, ferried Francisco M. across the river to Paraguay. Francisco gave him a booklet, told him about the love of Jesus, and then prayed for him. Eduardo read and thought a lot about the booklet, and when Francisco returned, Eduardo asked him how to receive Christ. In the middle of the river, Eduardo knelt in his canoe and accepted Jesus as his personal Savior.

Pastor Roberto, as he visited a geriatric center located in a suburb of Buenos Aires, where many of the residents have accepted Jesus as their personal Savior. "It is through the booklets that they have confidence in their salvation and eternity," Rosa B. told him. "Many of these patients will enter eternity in the coming months. We have had the favor of God to share the gospel in the last days of their lives, and many have received salvation."

"My name is Zebulun Z. from Lusaka. I have not been a Christian before, and I had nothing to do with God's Word. I lived in my own world, and I never knew how much God loves me. My life changed when I read the booklet Who Am I that a King Would Die in My Place?. It touched my heart. Considering the kind of life I lived, I never expected to be loved by God. But now I am a child of God. I accepted Jesus Christ as my Savior after reading the booklet and the pastor prayed for me."

Although there are many online resources, the need for "paper missionaries" continues to grow. Eric N. wrote, "My friend Sadia, an African refugee in Spain, is a cultural Muslim but has been inquiring about Christian beliefs because of our friendship. I'd like him to have a physical booklet he can hold onto while he investigates the person of Jesus." Each booklet held in the hand is a gift of hope.

The King Web Press prints the inside pages of the booklets using close to nine **rolls of paper** each day. Each roll is 12 miles long, weighs 1,500 pounds, and produces about 85,000 booklets. The colorful booklet covers are printed on **sheets of paper** by the Manroland Press. Daily, 35,000 sheets pass through the press, producing 560,000 booklet covers.

- ## A gift of \$1,485 provides a roll of paper for the web press.
- ** A gift of \$1,139 provides a pallet of 8,500 sheets of paper.

Ink is vital to the process of printing. Ink for the King Web Press comes in large 425-pound barrels and are emptied in 4-5 days. The Manroland Press uses five cans of each ink color in a week. Each 5-pound can of ink costs \$23.75. A day's worth of color ink produces about 58,000 four-color Scripture booklet covers.

- # A gift of \$664 provides a week's worth of black ink.
- ## A gift of \$95 provides a day's worth of color ink.

The **Scripture booklets** are easily transported because 500 copies fit in a 10-pound box. When you consider one booklet is often shared with several others, imagine the impact a single box will make!

- ** A monthly gift of \$30 provides one box of 500 booklets.
- **A** monthly gift of \$120 provides about four boxes of booklets.
