When Damar Hamlin suffered cardiac arrest on the football field in 2023, a commentator said, "70,000 fans are praying for this young man right now." Statistically speaking, 54% of those believed in higher powers or forces, 4% were atheists, and 32% irreligious. So, to whom were most of them praying? In the end, the young man's survival was credited to the quick actions of paramedics, and the stellar local medical facilities.

It is regrettable that prayer was politicized after the shooting of students at the Annunciation Catholic School. However, the media coverage exposed the common idea that prayer is a power unto itself, as exemplified in the statement, "Prayer does not end school shootings."

Prayer is a request made of God to use His power on our behalf. **He who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him** (Hebrews 11:6b). Jesus uses interactive verbs when teaching His disciples to pray. **"So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened."** He ends with the words, **"How much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"** (Luke 11:9-13) Notice the words **ASK HIM**.

God's Spirit is important because **the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought. And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God. He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things** (Romans 8:26a, 28a, 32)? **Wait on the LORD; be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart** (Psalm 27:14a).

(Pray for 40 million people in Java Indonesia who speak Sundanese.)

- 6 PRAY that the Lord will anoint and ordain a person to be president of WMP who has ministry insights and managerial skills.
(Pray for the Surigaonon people in the Philippines speaking Surigaonon.)
"You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do." — John 8:44a
- 7 PRAISE THE LORD for raising \$900,000 for new equipment via the Twelve:24 campaign.
(Pray for the people of the Democratic Republic of the Congo who speak Swahili.)
