## Ministry in the Islands of the South Pacific

*If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, even there Your hand shall lead me, and Your right hand shall hold me.*

—Psalm 139:9-10

West of Australia and south of Asia, tucked away in the South Pacific Sea, are fourteen island nations. These do not often make the news, and it is easy to forget the 46.6 million people living on these islands. But God has not forgotten them and has provided those who are sharing His Word through WMP Scripture booklets in Samoa, Fiji, Kiribati, Micronesia, Vanuatu, Tonga, Papua New Guinea, and the Solomon Islands.

Bougainville is the largest and most northern of six islands that make up the Solomon Islands. Abby and Dave D. live in Canada, but have distributed WMP booklets in Mozambique, Eswatini, South Africa, Vanuatu, Fiji, and the Solomon Islands. “When Abby and I were on a mission trip in the Solomon Islands, we were at Faro Island in the northwest part of the country. I saw Bougainville Island in the distance and sensed that God would send me there one day. That was at least 10 years ago, [but] recently Bougainville has been on my heart and mind. We plan to spend January and February 2026 on the island.”





WMP produces *Help From Above* in the Roviana language spoken in the Solomon Islands. Dave contacted WMP for a couple of boxes to take in a suitcase, but **God had other plans**. Arrangements were made to include 336 boxes on a container leaving for Papua New Guinea in December. These were shipped to Dave and Abby in Bougainville, giving them the evangelistic tools they need to do outreach this month. “We look forward to what God is about to do in Bougainville Island in the New Year, with almost 170,000 booklets designated for this large and needy island.”

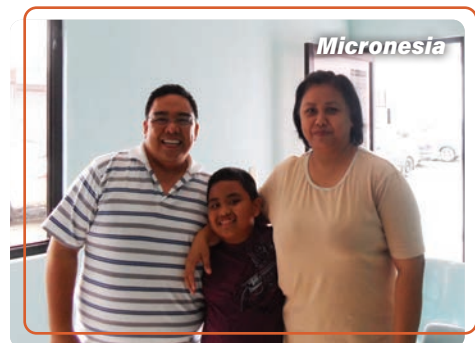
**The timing for Dave and Abby is no coincidence**, as the container sent to Papua New Guinea (PNG) is the first to go after a seven-year hiatus. PNG has over 800 languages

spoken on 600 islands, many of which do not have Scripture in their language. Aaron N., WMP National Coordinator and EHC director for the country, strives to bring the gospel to every island, town, and home. He received a forty-foot container of 3,773 boxes of Tok Pisin and English booklets for distribution throughout the island and beyond.

From a previous container shipment, Mr. and Mrs. John P. testified, “A friend gave us a booklet about the one true God. As we studied this booklet we were really interested. We wrote WMP and they sent us other booklets like *The Amazing Life of Jesus Christ*. As we studied the booklets, we believed there is one true God and His name is Jesus. We were baptized and began witnessing.

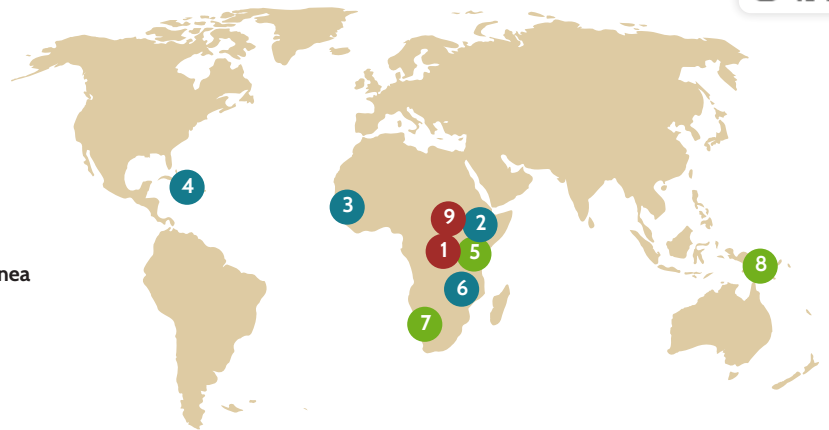
