

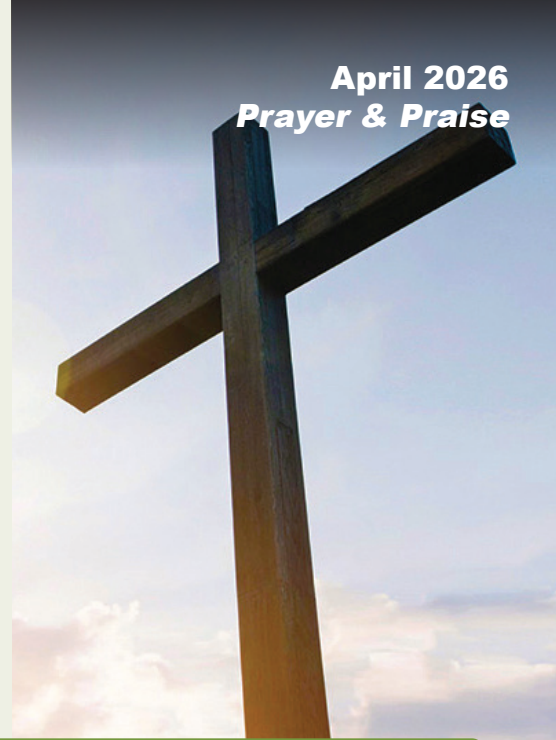
Greetings to all my Friends,

Can any of us imagine what it was like to talk to the resurrected Jesus? He was dead—not for a short time on an operating table, but for three days, buried, and in the ground dead. Some disciples helped remove His body from the cross, carried His lifeless body to the tomb, wrapped the corpse in grave clothes and spices, and arranged it on the floor. There was no question. Jesus was dead.

Then Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them...and He said to them, “Why are you troubled? And why do doubts arise in your hearts? Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have.” (Luke 24:36b, 38-39) Talk about blowing ones mind! As they examined His hands and side they saw and felt a vibrant living human body. Not the cold lifeless flesh of death, but the warm, healthy flesh of life. He was risen and alive.

Did they dare (or would they want) to disobey a man raised from the dead? “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations. You are witnesses of these things. (Matthew 28:18b, 19a, Luke 24:48b) Jesus is resurrected still. His command to witness still valid. His expectations are the same. Do we dare ignore Jesus? May we be like the disciples who went out and preached everywhere. (Mark 16:20a)
