New Convert Injured in Accident Keeps the Faith

During a baptismal service, Brother M. handed out World Missionary Press Scripture booklets to a woman from a nearby village. She read it and contacted him, wanting to know more about Jesus. **After meeting with him, she surrendered her life to the Lord.** On the day she planned to be baptized, she was involved in a terrible accident. Her



injuries were so severe that many believed she had died. When Brother M. visited her in the hospital, he worried she might question her faith. Instead, she told him, "Thank you for praying for me. God has saved me." Hearing those words brought great joy. Seven months later, a special baptismal service was held just for her. Her father, mother, and brother also accepted Christ and were baptized. Today, she leads a church in her own home.

Ramiro and Family Grateful to be Alive

World Missionary Press offered hope to families who lost everything when the Cazonces River quickly rose over seven meters in Poza Rica, Veracruz, Mexico. Ramiro, 36, saw his home and belongings washed away within minutes. His family survived but now sleeps on the street. As churches delivered emergency supplies, a booklet from World Missionary Press was given to him. **Ramiro found unexpected hope.** He remembered attending church with his grandmother as a child, and through a simple pantry of food and a Scripture booklet, he was reminded that God loves him. "Thank God, my family and I are alive," he said. "We will be reading the Bible, and we will look for a church."

“God, in His kindness, allowed me to run a small fruit and grocery store called La Manzanita. It was there that I discovered my business could also be a place of evangelism.
