Help From Above (HFA): Designed to lead the reader to Christ and to live a victorious life. Good for evangelism and follow-up of new believers.



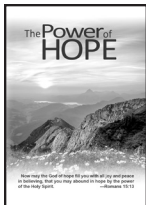
How to Know God (HKG): Tells how to have a personal relationship with God. Designed for Muslims, but excellent as a general evangelistic tool.



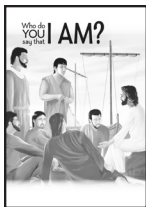
The Way to God (WTG): Especially for children. Its purpose is to share God's love and plan of salvation and how to live for Jesus. Features illustrations and a larger type size.



Let's Praise the Lord! (PTL): Especially for Christians. Compiled as a practical tool for praising God faithfully and joyfully.



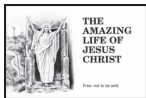

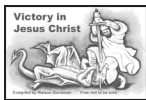

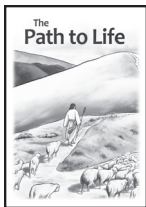
