One evening Jesus warned His disciples of conditions that would characterize the future: *"Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. Many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another."* Furthermore, *"because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold"* (Matthew 24:7a, 10, 12). Jesus' words certainly resonate with many of the challenges we see today. Yet His message did not end with warning. He offered assurance that God's purposes would prevail.

He declared, *"For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be"* (v. 27). *"He who endures to the end shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come"* (vs. 13-14). The nations may rage, but Jesus has overcome the world and offers His followers enduring peace.
